## Westchase's New Tower



Granite Briarpark Green has delivered. The 300k SF Class-A office tower developed by Granite Properties reaches 12 stories in Westchase. It features a two-story entry lobby called the "corporate living room." (If they really wanna give it the living room feel it will have your parents watching re-runs of Gomer Pyle U.S.M.C.) Granite development manager Aaron Bidne says the goal was for Briarpark Green to be the new benchmark for Class-A office space in Westchase. It will receive LEED Gold; sustainable features include energy performance 21% above construction standards. Granite declined to comment on leasing activity at the project, but did tell us they should have something to announce soon.



Hoar was GC and PGAL handled design. Hoar's Nathan Kolbaba says a unique feature of the project is the fitness center—it's in the garage, making use of what was a dead space. He says it has a water feature and is a really neat facility. Some challenges in the process: A really tight site, meshing three materials on the skin (Hoar had 13 swing stages going at once to get it done), and an incident of copper piping being stolen (the sub painted it all black and none was stolen again).
